The Fabio Tiboni gallery presents the first solo exhibition in Bologna of the young Tuscan artist Giovanni Ozzola.

The exhibition presents a series of previously unexhibited photographs of both small and large format as well as a video work created just for this occasion.

The photographic project and video that Ozzola has created for this exhibition were born of an idea to create a closer relationship between the works themselves and the space in which they are installed; space being conceived of as a dimension containing specific architectonic elements but also as a catalyst for suggestions and moods. The aesthetic investigation enclosed in each work thus fully explores and links itself to the architectonic structure and atmosphere of the gallery. The interpretative key to this project is the investigation of sensations and emotive assonances which generate themselves through images and place through the observation of light. Light is always a fundamental component of Ozzola's works, which seek the iconic results of the sources of light in the direct relationship between the context of origin and that of the exhibition.

Light, the artist says, "serves to shorten distances with the world". Like a diaphragm, his gaze gathers the multiple emotive passages which transit in our perception and which go on to define our daily experience of the world, just as that of our unconscious which translates our vision of it.

The exhibition is completed by a text from Elisa Del Prete which, developed together with the artist, reflects on the concepts which lie at the base of his investigations.
